## **BREAKOUT SESSION PROPOSAL**

Breakout sessions are hands-on classes that will offer a variety of projects or techniques that can be accomplished in a 50-minute time slot, or a 2- hour time slot (limited number).

We are looking for instructors with great ideas, projects and techniques to share. Formal teaching experience is NOT required – if you have an idea and can show a group of fellow fiber enthusiasts how to do it, please submit the form below.

Proposals must be based on a fiber art process with tips for accomplishing and suggestions for supply resources. Processes might deal with weaving, spinning, fiber prep, dyeing, felting, knit or crochet, basketry, stitching, lace or related techniques.

**Deadline for applications is April 30, 2021.** Applications may be submitted online or by mail (postmarked by the deadline).

Acceptance notifications will be sent out by May 15, 2021 via email. Details on parking, setup and other information will be provided at that time.

- All applications will be reviewed by the committee so we can provide for a variety of interests and experience levels.
- Be sure to note in the form if water will be needed; we will locate these classes as near as possible to a water source, but bring containers to carry water to the classroom.
- Electricity is available in all classrooms; if needed, bring your own cords.
- We require at least one high-quality photo of the process or finished product for use on the website. Include a print photo with the form or email to <a href="mailto:wichitaweavers@gmail.com">wichitaweavers@gmail.com</a> with the class name in the subject line.
- Instructors will provide supplies and materials, but may request that attendees bring items or tools such as scissors, needles, etc. List these on the proposal form.
- Attendees will select sessions during registration, but will pay instructors directly at the beginning of the class. Please state the total fee for your session in the form. Collecting those fees will be the responsibility of each instructor.
- Breakout sessions will be held on *Friday*, *Nov*. 5 from 1 4 pm, and *Saturday*, *Nov*. 6 from 9 11 am and 1 4 pm. Please indicate your availability and preference, and we'll do our best to accommodate!
- If we anticipate high interest, we may ask an instructor to repeat a session.
- Organizers will provide a class list to each instructor by Oct. 25.

- If there are openings, they may be filled at sign-in on Friday, Nov. 5 or Saturday, Nov. 6.
- All events will be under the control and direction of the chairperson(s) for this event.
